Phonics-

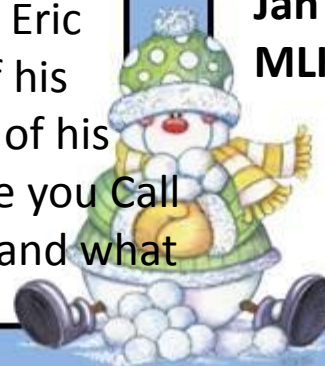
We will be continuing on with our sight words. Students will also practice rhyming words and syllables.

Phonics-This month we will be working on letter identification of t,b,f,n,m to name a few. We will be practicing hearing rhyming words, and how to identify and write our own names.

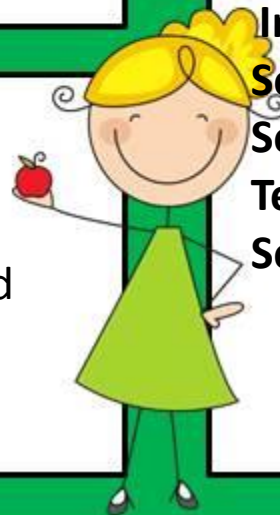
